## Exhibit Guidelines for Submitting Artwork

1. Exhibitors must be a **paid-up member** of the R.A.A.
2. The Art Association reserves the right to reject **for any reason** any artwork considered inappropriate or not meeting the highest standards. Frontal nudity is not allowed to be exhibited per GRF and John Muir Clinic.
3. **Recommended Size Range:** Minimum 14” x 18” and maximum 48” x 50”.
4. **Framing:** Watercolor, gouache, pencil, ink, pastel, and collage paintings must be neatly matted and in good condition. Artwork requiring transparent protection must be well-framed using acrylic (Plexiglas) panels only. Paintings framed with glass will not be accepted. \*(see exception below)

Satisfactory framing must also be used with oil and acrylic paintings. Unframed artwork will be accepted provided the top, bottom, and side panels are painted to harmonize with the painting. The backing must be clean with no nails showing. Unprofessional backings attached in an untidy or unsecure method, will not be accepted.

Picture wire should have its suspension point **2-3 inches below top edge** of the frame (see Diagram enclosed). Wire ends should be secured in a manner that protects those hanging the artwork from injury as well as preventing damage to the walls on which the work hangs.

5. **Important Notice:**  
Artwork must be picked up at the time exhibit closes. Unless arrangements are made for later pick up, all unclaimed artwork will be considered abandoned after **3 months** from close of exhibit and will be sold or disposed of for account of R.A.A.
6. **If a painting is sold,** please notify the Exhibits Chairperson to have the records and labeling changed and replace the picture promptly. A 10% commission check payable to R.A.A. must be sent to the Treasurer, R.A.A., P.O. Box 2070, Walnut Creek, CA 94595.

\*Exception: Smaller sized pastels may be covered with glass, but may also be rejected for excessive weight at the discretion of the exhibit committee.
