Approval of Minutes: The April 10, 2019 Minutes were approved as read.

Committee Reports:

Membership: In her absence, Chair., Susie Symons, sent a report. There are 285 members. Susie has been adding names to the roster. John has been updating Constant Contact from Mail Chimp.

Education/Workshops: Chair, Cathy Brostrand was absent. John did a policy sheet of class rosters using PDF and Excel. There was a discussion about fee policy. The goal is better policy. Display units set up is the same as the Soiree. Last year some teachers left their paintings, instead of hanging their own paintings. They need to be reminded of the procedure.
